The Opportunity and Requirements of the Position

The Senior Director of Programs oversees programmatic Department Heads who (along with their assistants and staff) implement programming for students: The Principal, Residential Director, Center for Autism Director, and Recreational Therapist. The Senior Director of Programs reports to the Executive Director and has responsibility for these essential functions:

- Advance the KDS mission and legacy by leading department heads to implement highquality educational, residential, and recreational services
- Motivate, evaluate and mentor a strong and cohesive team of Department heads
- Empower direct reports to troubleshoot and problem-solve, including emergency situations

- Lead direct reports to operate in a way that is compliant with licensing and accrediting agencies, while respecting the individuality and needs of students and their families
- Promote the organization's employee engagement framework, helping ensure that department heads implement a quality employee experience for their staff members
- Work cooperatively with the other members of the Senior Leadership Team, mitigating risk and charting a path toward organization-wide strategic initiatives
- Serve as a member of internal leadership teams, including Performance and Quality Improvement (PQI) Team and Treatment Teams
- Be on-call (and available in-person as needed), with other Senior Leadership staff members, in emergencies
